### ALTERNATIVE DISCIPLINE

#### A. SATURDAY SCHOOL Section in the handbook page 30

Saturday School is a program designed to discipline students without causing them to miss classes. It is a four-hour session held each Saturday in the high school study hall from 8:00 a.m. to 12 noon. Students will be placed in Saturday School for infractions such as missing detention hall, excessive tardies, truancy, smoking and other nuisance offences to be determined by the building principal. Once Saturday School has been assigned for a particular misbehavior, it will not be assigned again for the same misbehavior. Students will be limited to three assignments to Saturday School per semester. After three assignments to Saturday school, students will be assigned out-of-school suspensions. Failure to attend Saturday School will result in a three day in-school suspension. Should have read out of school suspension.
