

Nationally Chartered Honor Societies

National Honor Society

- FOCUS:** The components of National Honor Society are character, leadership, scholarship and service.
- MEMBERSHIP:** Students with a cumulative GPA of 3.3 or above at the end of their sophomore year are invited to join National Honor Society. To maintain membership, students must pay dues, be in regular attendance at monthly meetings and maintain a 3.3 GPA or higher.
- ACTIVITIES:** NHS has a continuing service project of collecting eye glasses to send to 3rd world countries. The group also sponsors a family at Easter with a food basket and Easter baskets for the children.

Société Honoraire de Français / French Honor Society

- MEMBERSHIP:** Prerequisite: 4 semesters of "A" in French; a "B" average in all other subjects. No "U's" in conduct. Seniors may have 3 semesters of "A" and 1 semester of "B" in French, with a "B" average in all other subjects.
- INITIATION:** Second semester
- ACTIVITIES:** SHF members participate in Homecoming Activities, collect cans for the 8th Street Mission; participate in a project for Ronald McDonald House, and other altruistic activities. Opportunities for teaching French materials in lower grades for short periods are also available. A field trip to a French culture related activity is provided during the school year.
- RECOGNITION:** Graduating senior members wear a blue/white/red honor cord and receive a special insignia on their diplomas.

Sociedad Honoraria Hispánica / Spanish Honor Society

- MEMBERSHIP:** 2 A's and 1 B or 3 A's in 3 semesters of Spanish at MHS or 2 A's and 2 B's or better in 4 semesters
- INDUCTION:** SHH is an honorary organization. Inductions are held in the spring. All inductees receive a certificate and pin when they are inducted. Students with 3 A's in 3 semesters are rewarded with a mug or other item as a token of their excellence, and are recognized as Highest Honor members. Although the two groups are separate and students do not have to belong to Spanish Club to be inducted into SHH, SHH members are often invited to participate in activities along with the Spanish Club throughout the year. Field trips are taken whenever there are events that are of special interest to the members.

Mu Alpha Theta

- FOCUS:** Mu Alpha Theta is an honorary math club for high school and junior college students. The purpose of the club is to promote enjoyment, scholarship and understanding of mathematics.
- MEMBERSHIP:** Students must earn a minimum grade of B in all mathematics courses.
- RECOGNITION:** To be eligible to wear the gold honor cord and to receive a special insignia on their diplomas, students must be enrolled in Honors Algebra II, trigonometry/advanced math, A.P. statistics, or calculus during their senior year. Chemistry II or physics will also count as a mathematics course.
- ACTIVITIES:** Mu Alpha Theta members participate in Homecoming Activities, collect food items at Thanksgiving and collect Christmas gifts for needy children at Christmas. In the spring, the members work with elementary children on special mathematics projects. Mu Alpha Theta also gives scholarships to deserving seniors at graduation.
